Download

Download k9copy-2.3.8-1.el6.x86_64.rpm

Download k9copy-2.3.8-1.el6.x86_64.rpm for CentOS 6 from the LinuxTECH repository.

Install Howto

Create the repository config file /etc/yum.repos.d/linuxtech.repo:

```
[linuxtech]
name=LinuxTECH
baseurl=http://pkgrepo.linuxtech.net/el6/release/
enabled=1
gpgcheck=1
gpgkey= http://pkgrepo.linuxtech.net/el6/release/RPM-GPG-KEY-LinuxTECH.NET
```

Install k9copy rpm package:

```
# yum install k9copy
```

After some trial and error, I finally got this all done. (All in the terminal too). However, this is what was produced in the terminal afterwards.
