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Hello, thanks for what you are offering the CentOS/RHEL community.

As near as I can determine, there's been no new builds of MAME <http://www.mamedev.org/> for RHEL or CentOS since sdlmame 0.115 (for CentOS 5 and CentOS 6.), which is many years ago, and there's no CentOS 7 packages.

MAME is usually easy enough to build from source but for those who can't, it could use a new package.

Fedora more or less is generating monthly builds for the last many months. IDK if that will be of any help.

It's also in Debian, FreeBSD and OpenBSD (meaning its past license issues seem to have been resolved to their liking enough to land it in their main repos.)
