I really do not want your repo to descend into the state that the old rpmforge did so from my POV, I would rather you shut up shop completely than left your old packages around if you are no longer able to keep them up to date. It would create a lot of noise but in the long term, it's a better option than leaving unmaintained packages with known security problems lying around.
